If an answer has a word limit then assume that a page is about 200 words long, so a 500 word answer (for example) would be $2\frac{1}{2}$ pages long.

Your answers will be graded for accuracy, clarity, and completeness. Answers that are illegible, unintelligible, or in the colour red will not receive passing grades. Unless a question states otherwise you need to justify your answers.

If you cannot completely answer a question then try to define the relevant terms and explain their importance. If you think that a question is ambiguous then clearly state a resonable assumption as part of your answer.

You may ask your professor or TA for clarification of any of the questions if they are present.
